KC Royals Play Ball!

Tour overview: Enjoy the hoopla and excitement of a professional ball game in world famous Kauffman Stadium....without all the fuss. We'll make all the arrangements—buy the tickets, find the seats, arrange for food and drive you home afterwards (at least back to the Kauffman Museum parking lot!). **Let us take you out to the ball game!**

Pre-tour presentation: Prior to the trip (date to be determined), Dr. John Dreifort from WSU will share important and entertaining baseball facts and trivia. Professor Dreifort is a specialist in modern European diplomacy and the history of baseball.

Breakfast. We'll serve breakfast muffins and juice on the bus and make a stop for coffee (pay on your own) along the way.

Behind the scenes tour at Kauffman Stadium. Our 90-minute tour of the "The K" will include the Royals dugout, Outfield Plaza, the press box, the interview room and the Royals Hall of Fame.

Lunch, Arthur Bryant's Barbecue. For lunch we'll head to the 18th and Vine district. Arthur Bryant created a sauce that has attracted celebrities and U.S. presidents to his restaurant considered the best in the world by *New Yorker* columnist Calvin Trillin.

Negro Leagues Baseball Museum and American Jazz Museum. Down the street from lunch, two museums are housed on the same site. The NLBM chronicles the stars and stories of America's favorite pastime from the leagues' origin after the Civil War to their demise in the 1960s. Next door is the American Jazz Museum with many listening stations, touch-screens and custom-mixing soundboards.

Kansas City Royals vs. the Oakland As. From our covered seating area (good for sun or drizzle) along the third base line you'll be able to revisit the Hall of Fame we saw earlier in the day and have a great view of the fountains, state of the art score board and the field.

Supper at the stadium. Your game ticket will be "loaded" with a specific amount of "cash" to use at the concession stands for food or merchandise around the facility. Museum staff along on the bus tour can help with this process if you wish!

Cost includes all meals, all admissions, travel by modern motor coach with a restroom, and gratuities. Fee is refundable (minus \$40 processing fee) prior to August 30. After the deadline, refunds depend on site policies and waiting lists. No refunds given 48 hours or less prior to departure.
